Bar Cart

Make a stylish bar cart this summer with Krylon®!

SKILL LEVEL:

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PROJECT TIME: 8 HRS



MATERIALS

- **Krylon COLORmaxx™ Paint + Primer**
Satin Ivory (8 cans), Gloss Khaki (4 cans)
- Wood pallets
- Eye protection
- Fasteners
- 4 Swiveling, locking casters
- Reciprocating saw with long carbide-tipped demolition blade
- Pneumatic stapler
- Circular saw
- Wire brush
- Landscape blower

OPTIONAL TOOLS:

- Miter saw
- Jigsaw
- Table saw

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 Before you begin, ensure you have a solid work station and are following proper safety instructions while operating around saws and blades.
- 2 Break apart the pallet by cutting the pallet nails with a long carbide-tipped demolition blade and separate the individual pieces of wood.
- 3 Cut 8 pieces of the pallet wood into 36-inch boards while being cautious of extra nails.
- 4 Connect two pieces of wood on their sides with a pneumatic stapler to create an L-frame.
- 5 Repeat with the remaining 6 pieces of wood to create a total of 4 L-frames. These will be the corners of the bar cart frame.
- 6 Connect two L-brackets together with 22 1/2-inch long horizontal boards. Repeat with other two L-brackets. Do this by attaching the horizontal boards on the inside corners of the L-frames with a pneumatic stapler. This creates the front and back faces.
- 7 Then connect the two front and back faces separated by a 14-inch horizontal boards. This will create a frame connecting the four corners together.
- 8 Use filler boards to make the front and side faces of the bar cart frame a flush surface. Attach with pneumatic stapler. Leave the back face open.
- 9 Gather approximately 30 pieces of pallet wood that have been cut and prepare the boards with a wire brush to smooth and remove excess dirt and debris. Blow away excess dust with a landscape blower.
- 10 Before you begin painting, read the can label for proper application and safety instructions. Paint 20 boards with Krylon COLORmaxx Paint + Primer in Satin Ivory and 10 boards with Krylon COLORmaxx Paint + Primer in Gloss Khaki with 2 - 3 coats. Allow to dry.
- 11 Once fully dry, attach the painted boards diagonally in varying colors for a striping effect to the front face of the cart. Attach horizontal boards to the two sides of the cart. Leave the back face open.
- 12 Flip the cart on its side and attach two horizontal boards with the pneumatic stapler. Fasten the casters in each corner of the bar cart.
- 13 Create the top of the bar cart by making a flush rectangle 36 inches by 16 inches. Pneumatic staple this to the top of the bar cart.
- 14 For additional details, add extra boards on the inside of the bar cart to create storage and shelving. Also, cut notches with a jigsaw for hanging glasses and bottle storage. You may also cut boards with notches to hang towels on the sides of the cart.
- 15 Enjoy your newly designed bar cart!

Argyle Beverage Tub

Serve your summer-time drinks from this stylish beverage tub!

SKILL LEVEL:

1

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PROJECT TIME: 3 HRS (plus drying time)



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 Prepare tub by cleaning it well.
- 2 Mask edges and handles with tape.
- 3 Turn upside down on masked table and spray with Krylon Fusion in Red Pepper; allow to dry completely.
- 4 On craft paper, make a diamond shape template.
- 5 To determine the dimensions for the diamond template, measure the height of the tub between the edges, and for the width, the measurement around the center of the tub divided by eight.
- 6 Adjust to best fit your particular tub.
- 7 Use the diamond template to trace onto adhesive-backed vinyl and cut out eight diamonds.
- 8 Position and adhere diamond masks onto sides of tub.
- 9 Spray masked tub with Krylon Fusion in Patriotic Blue.
- 10 Carefully remove masks before paint is completely dry to avoid peeling paint.
- 11 Allow to dry completely.
- 12 Using Krylon Paint Pen in Ocean Blue, outline each of the red diamonds; allow to dry.
- 13 Using the craft paper diamond template you created in step three, and a Krylon Paint Pen in White, draw small stitches overlapping red diamonds.

- Galvanized tub: 5.5 gallon

Fun, glittery pot and vases will add sparkle and shine to your summer gatherings.

PROJECT TIME: 3 HRS (plus drying time)

MATERIALS

- Krylon® COLORmaxx™ Primer - White
- Krylon COLORmaxx Paint + Primer
Gloss White, Regal Blue, Cherry Red
- Krylon Glitter Blast™
Diamond Dust, Twilight Sky, Cherry Bomb
- 1 tall, thin glass vase
- 1 short, wide glass vase
- 1 - 4 ½" wide x 5 ½" tall clay pot
- Blue painter's tape, 1 ½" wide and 2" wide

INSTRUCTIONS

Striped Vase Instructions

- 1- Apply a light coat of COLORmaxx™ Gloss White Paint to the vase; repeat until vase is completely covered, allowing time to dry in between coats.
- 2- Apply a light coat of Glitter Blast Diamond Dust to the vase; repeat until vase is completely covered, allowing time to dry in between coats.
- 3- Use the 1 ½" wide blue painter's tape to mask off stripes on the vase.
- 4- Keep the stripes evenly spaced and match up tape at ends for a smooth line.
- 5- Apply a light coat of COLORmaxx Gloss Cherry Red paint to the vase; repeat until vase is completely covered, allowing time to dry in between coats.
- 6- Apply a light coat of Glitter Blast Cherry Bomb to the vase; repeat until vase is completely covered, allowing time to dry in between coats.
- 7- Remove tape.

Blue with White Stars Vase Instructions:

- 1- Apply a light coat of COLORmaxx Gloss White paint to the vase; repeat until vase is completely covered, allowing time to dry in between coats.

INSTRUCTIONS (continued)

Blue with White Stars Vase Instructions:

- 2- Apply a light coat of Glitter Blast Diamond Dust to the vase; repeat until vase is completely covered, allowing time to dry in between coats.
- 3- Go online to look for a star shape that you would like to use.
- 4- Use a photo editing program to change the size of the star, if needed.
- 5- Make sure it is no larger than 2" wide.
- 6- Print the star shape onto cardstock and cut out to use as a template.
- 7- Rip off a piece of 2" wide blue painter's tape that is big enough to fit the star template.
- 8- Stick the star template lightly to the sticky side of the tape.
- 9- Use sharp scissors to cut out the shape from the tape.
- 10- Gently peel the cardstock star template from the tape.
- 11- Firmly press the tape star onto the vase.
- 12- Repeat step four until you have a star pattern that you like around the vase.
- 13- Apply a light coat of COLORmaxx Gloss Regal Blue paint to the vase.
- 14- Repeat until vase is completely covered, allowing time to dry in between coats.
- 15- Apply a light coat of Glitter Blast Twilight Sky to the vase. Repeat until vase is completely covered, allowing time to dry in between coats.
- 16- Remove tape.

Clay Pot Instructions:

- 1- Cover the clay pot with a light coat of COLORmaxx White Primer; repeat until pot is completely covered, allowing time to dry between coats.
- 2- Apply a light coat of COLORmaxx Gloss White Paint to the pot; repeat until pot is completely covered, allowing time to dry in between coats.
- 3- Apply a light coat of Glitter Blast Diamond Dust to the pot; repeat until pot is completely covered, allowing time to dry in between coats.
- 4- Use a photo editing program to change the size of the star, if needed.
- 5- Use the 1 ½" wide painter's tape to carefully mask off the rim of the pot.
- 6- Cover the hole on the bottom on the inside of the pot with a piece of tape.
- 7- Turn the pot upside down.
- 8- Apply a light coat of COLORmaxx Cherry Red paint to the pot; repeat until pot is completely covered, allowing time to dry in between coats.
- 9- Apply a light coat of Glitter Blast Cherry Bomb to the pot; repeat until pot is completely covered, allowing time to dry in between coats.
- 10- Remove tape.

SKILL LEVEL:

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PROJECT TIME: 1-2 HRS



INSTRUCTIONS

All paint should be used according to manufacturer's instructions.

- 1 Metal plates and glass candleholders: Spray paint with COLORmaxx Ballet Slipper Pink, Citrus Green, Blue Ocean Breeze and Iris.
- 2 Wooden tray: If the surface is rough, sand the tray before spraying. Cover with a few coats of COLORmaxx Ballet Slipper Pink. To give it a little something extra, use Washi Tape to make diagonal stripes on the tray.
- 3 Bunting (flag banner): Cut triangles out of burlap ribbon and spray paint both sides of the triangles with COLORmaxx Sunrise. To assemble, glue the triangles onto jute twine.
- 4 Dessert tray: spray paint with COLORmaxx Blue Ocean Breeze.
- 5 Flower pot and metal tub: Spray paint with COLORmaxx Ballet Slipper Pink. Use them for napkins, utensils and drinks!

Patio Umbrella

PROJECT TIME: 2 HRS



INSTRUCTIONS

Find an old patio umbrella.

MATERIALS

- **Krylon COLORMaxx Paint + Primer**
Blue Ocean Breeze (5 cans)
- **Krylon Fusion All-In-One™ Paint + Primer**
Metallic Copper (1 can)
- Respirator or mask
- Stencils (optional - additional paint needed)
- **Krylon Easy-Tack™ Repositionable Adhesive (optional)**
- Patio umbrella

- 1 Set up work space in a well ventilated area. Protect the area with rosin paper, plastic or tarp.
- 2 Remove the top cap from the umbrella, following with each arm from the canvas.
- 3 Lay the umbrella canopy as flat as possible on work surface.
- 4 Apply the first coat of Krylon COLORMaxx in Blue Ocean Breeze to the canvas one section at a time.
- 5 Apply a second coat of Krylon COLORMaxx in Blue Ocean Breeze. Allow time to dry.
- 6 Customize your umbrella by using a stencil. Use Krylon Easy-Tack Repositionable Adhesive to hold stencil in place and apply Krylon COLORMaxx spray paint in a contrasting color of your choice. (Optional)
- 7 Apply two coats of Krylon Fusion All-In-One Metallic Copper to the base .
- 8 Apply two coats of Krylon Fusion All-In-One Metallic Copper to the canopy support.
- 9 Allow time for all paint to completely dry.
- 10 Reassemble the canopy support to the umbrella.
- 11 Set up the base, then insert the canopy support with the umbrella.

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PROJECT TIME: 1-2 HRS



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 Protect the work surface with newspaper.
- 2 Remove all dust with a tack cloth.
- 3 Tape off areas that won't be painted with newspaper and painter's tape.
- 4 Paint open areas with Krylon COLORmaxx™ Primer.
- 5 Let dry.
- 6 Paint open areas with Krylon COLORmaxx™ Paint + Primer.
- 7 Let dry and remove the masking.
- 8 Let dry thoroughly.

MATERIALS

- **Krylon COLORmaxx™ Paint + Primer**
True Blue, Sun Yellow, Dover White
- **Krylon COLORmaxx™ Primer**
White
- Protective gloves and eye wear
- Newspaper to protect work surface and for masking
- Tack cloth
- Painter's tape
